Dear Knights of Columbus,

My name is Lydia Wrobel and I am writing to tell you about an exciting opportunity I have recently received and to ask for your help in making it a reality. I have been invited to be one of 135 Catholic young adults across the country who will volunteer for a year serving with NET Ministries. NET (National Evangelization Teams) is based in St. Paul, MN and since 1981, they have been sending out teams of young adults to travel across the United States to share their faith with youth on NET retreats.

In August I will participate in a five-week faith training program in St. Paul. Then from September to May, I will be leading retreats across the country and sharing my faith with teens. I learned about NET through my parents' previous involvement and other close family friends, and I'm taking this year to volunteer before I start college. I am looking forward to serving with NET because I enjoy working with young people and I want to take this opportunity to share my faith.

In the coming year, NET Ministries will share the Gospel with 60,000 young people. My team alone will offer 100 to 125 retreats and pray with over 8,000 youth! Please keep us all in your prayers as we do this work of Christ.

To make this year a success, I would like to ask you to partner with me. In order to cover the costs of training, healthcare and a small monthly stipend I need to raise \$5,000 for this year of service. I have included in this letter a diagram of how many partners I need to reach my goal of \$5,000. As you can see from the diagram, I need 22 donors giving gifts ranging from \$100 – \$1,000. I would like you to consider joining me in this mission of evangelization with a gift of within the above range. All gifts are appreciated. I would ask that you give what you are able to. Please review the information and if you are able to help, please fill out the inside flap of the enclosed envelope and return it to NET Ministries. NET Ministries is a registered 501(c)(3) tax exempt charitable organization.


