



Marian Hour of Prayer



Attachment #11: Letter from Holy Family Catholic Adoption Agency

Dear Worthy Grand Knight,

Knights of Columbus State Deputy Joe Konrardy has recently approved Holy Family Catholic Adoption Agency as a charity worthy of Knights of Columbus support. This agency was also originally approved for donations at the 2012 State Convention where information about this agency was distributed to the District Deputies to forward to their Grand Knights. I would be most happy to send that information again if you so desire.

This agency is a Catholic, non-profit, pro-life organization following in the footsteps of Blessed Mother Teresa by trying to save babies from abortion through the love of adoption. And we make adoption affordable to practicing Catholic couples (our adoption fees are only \$350!) so adoptive couples can join us outside abortion centers to pray and offer adoption.
