Youth Environment Training and Background Check Requirement

Youth Environment Training Requirement Only – also required for the Grand Knight

- Safe Environment Program Training and Background Check Requirements:
 - ✓ The council must submit a program director, family director and community director (on form #365). The grand knight cannot serve as one of these program directors.
 - ✓ Youth Environment Training must be completed by the Grand Knight and Program Director within 30 days after receiving emailed notification of this requirement.
 - ✓ Youth Environment Training <u>and</u> Background check must be completed by the Community Director and Family Director within 30 days after receiving emailed notification of this requirement.
- Semiannual Council Audit (Form #2395) due August 15th.
- Council Liability Insurance required by councils. Contact me if needing assistance.
- E990 Charitable Tax Filing required by councils. Contact me if needing assistance.
