Brothers, I have just received an Email from the GK in Paradise. This was in reply to my inquiry about what we, as a Council, could do for them. He said 69 of their 102 Brothers lost their homes, clothing, vehicles, etc. As a 12 year Brother in that Council it really hit close to home. This is in addition to the 8 of 10 Police Officers that lost their homes, clothing and vehicles. Yet they are still on duty, as are the Knights, trying to keep the town safe from looters and more fire.
