Timely Items

Priest needed for Upcoming Mass and Officer Installation Ceremony

Due to various reasons, we are without a priest for our upcoming Mass and Officer Installation Ceremony. <u>Please</u> talk to your priest and beg him to officiate. Tell him that he will be treated well! The Mass is scheduled to be held at Holy Name of Jesus on either Wednesday June 26th or Thursday July 11th. The date which best accommodates the priest's schedule (June 26 or July 11) will be our chosen date. Mass will start promptly at 6PM followed by the installation ceremony and a catered supper. As in previous years, each council is asked to contribute \$300 towards this event.

Election of Officers for the 2019-2020 Term

Councils should by now have a slate of officers for the upcoming term. Section 128 of the Laws of the Order indicates that officers are to be elected at a regular business meeting held between May 1 and June 15. Immediately after the election, the financial secretary should report the officers-elect to the Supreme Council using the Member Management application located in Officers Online on the Knights of Columbus web site.
